

Master of Cultural & Creative Practice Scholarships (Art & Design)

Closing dates: 1 June & 1 December

PURPOSE

The scholarship is offered to support postgraduate students and engender a creative led practice culture within the School of Art & Design in the of Cultural and Creative Practice (MCCP) programme.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of scholarships awarded will be determined annually
- The value of the scholarship is full tuition and learner services levy for the approved programme of study

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for up to three semesters of full-time study in the Master of Cultural & Creative Practice programme of study (180 points)
- Continuation of this award, for each subsequent semester, will be subject to the award recipient meeting all satisfactory progress requirements in either the Master of Cultural & Creative Practice programme

CRITERIA

- Applicant must be citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand
- This Scholarship is offered for entry into Cultural and Creative Practice (MCCP) programme., as delivered by the School of Art & Design
- These scholarships are available to applicants who can provide evidence of past academic excellence and/or research
- A high-quality research proposal and demonstration of a contribution to the overall research goals of the School. An indication of the discipline or inter-discipline practice that the research will be located in

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application for this scholarship is through the Auckland University of Technology (AUT) on-line scholarship application system. Applicants will be asked to upload:

- Academic transcripts for any study completed at a University other than AUT
- A two-page research proposal
- Any other supplementary documentation to support your application

SELECTION

- Recipients will be selected by the Art & Design Postgraduate Scholarship selection panel
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award
- The scholarship is not available to AUT academic members of staff

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- The recipient will be required to sign the AUT Postgraduate Scholarships Contract before payment of the award can commence
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
