Progression to the Bachelor of Business

Overview of Key Points

• Course	s are 15 poi											
	Courses are 15 points. Four 15-point courses each semester are equivalent to full-time study											
Each course requires around 10 hours of individual study per week in addition to lectures/ workshops												
Attending your lectures/workshops and submitting all assessments are key to your success												
4 courses 60 points per semester or 8 courses 120 points per year For StudyLink purposes, 0.8fte is considered full-time study (7 courses per year)												
Students who want to study part-time can do so, but there are time limits for completion and specific rules to consider for student loans and allowances												
The total time from first enrolment until the successful completion of all requirements must not normally exceed two years												
8 prescribed courses 120 points												
You will be block-enrolled into your courses, and you will be able to view your timetable in My AUT												
Courses are distinguished by a course code/occurrence, eg. BUSS505/W101, BUSS505/M205 W: City Campus; M: South Campus; A: North Campus; N: online W1/M1/N1: Semester 1 occurrence; W2/M2/N2: Semester 2 occurrence												
A pre-requisite is a specific course that must be successfully completed <u>before</u> studying another course. A co-requisite is a course that must either be studied <u>before or with</u> another course												
It is important to reach out early if you are struggling with any of your courses, and there are lots of resources and services available to help you get back on track. We encourage you to contact our Course Advice team who can advise on your situation and refer you as appropriate. Student progression is monitored and students who fail a core course or more than half of their enrolment will be referred to support services. Students who do not pass a course on the second attempt, or who fail more than half of their enrolment for a second consecutive semester, will need to apply for approval to continue												
When you've completed all your requirements and 120 points overall for the DipBus you'll be recommended for graduation and your parchment will be posted to you. Your qualification will also be made available through My eQuals												
Students who successfully complete the Diploma in Business: Degree Transition pathway can have 120 points credited over to the first year of the Bachelor of Business. You will then complete Years 2 and 3 of the BBus Bachelor of Business: Years 2-3
