STEP 1

The Student Liaison Advisor will call you to assess your safety and organise a meeting with you.

STEP 2

The Student Liaison Advisor will meet with you to:

- Discuss your disclosure, current safety and wellbeing
- Explain your ongoing support and reporting options
- Coordinate referrals and liaise with support services

The person who caused the harm is:

An AUT student

Your disclosure will be referred to the **Student Conduct Manager**

An AUT staff member

Your disclosure will be referred to **Employment Relations**

Not an AUT student or staff

The Student Liaison Advisor will help you make a Police report if that is your decision.
